
Literacy: Our literacy will reflect our class topic.

Our topic: Our Place in Space



French:

In French we will be learning our numbers, learning greetings and focusing on classroom instructions and items.



Computing: Our topic this term is 'IT around

We will be learning about what information technology is, where we can see it at home and around the world. We will also be investigating how technology improves our world and how to use information technology responsibly and safely.

Science: Our areas of learning will

Earth and Space: We will learn about the shapes and sizes of the Earth. Moon and Sun, why we have day and night, how the Earth orbits around the Sun, the Moon's phases and orbit around the Earth and the Solar System and man's journey into Space.

States of Matter: We will learn to compare and aroups materials together based on whether they are solids, liquids or gases, investigate how materials change when heated or cooled and understand the processes of evaporation and condensation.

Rocks and Fossils: We will learn to compare and group different rocks, investigate how fossils are formed and explore how soil is made.

Art:

Printing techniques

We will learn about different printing techniques and create sketch books to record observations. We will use these to review and revisit ideas and improve mastery of different techniques with a range of materials. This will lead to the children designing their own Christmas wrapping paper.

DT: Sculpture

We will be working in groups to design and make the solar system using a range of materials. Children will use technical knowledge to design their product and evaluate their work to make improvements.
