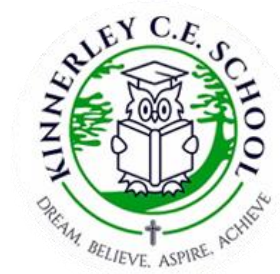




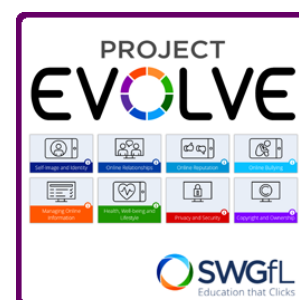
E-safety in School
