SCIENCE **Light and Shadows** We will be doing lots of enquiry, exploration and investigating. We will find out how we need light in order to see things and learn that darkness is the absence of light. We will notice that light is reflected from surfaces. We will recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect our eyes. We will explore how shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object and find patterns in the way that the size of shadows change.



DESIGN TECHNOLOGY **Seasonal Stockings.** During this festive unit children will develop and use their knowledge of, and skills in, a variety of sewing techniques for joining and decorating fabric in order to design and make their very own Christmas stocking!

MUSIC Exploring Sounds. Pupils will learn Learning how sounds are produced and how instruments are classified. They will learn about aerophones, idiophones and chordophones, and practise call and response.
