Fiction: War Horse

Children will explore War Horse by Michael Morpurgo, looking at multi-clause sentences and the subjunctive form, before planning and writing our own story with a historical setting.

White Feather

Looking at the book White Feather by Catherine and David MacPhail, we will create a diary entry from the point of view from a character within the story.

Non-Fiction: Advertising & Influence
